



## PULPITS ABLAZE

### 1. A Call to Awakening and Decision

- Joel 3:2 – Valley of Jehoshaphat (“valley of decision/judgment”)
- Amos 5:6 – “Seek the Lord and live”

These point to a moment of divine reckoning. Prophetically, this suggests:

- A time when people (or nations) are brought into a decision point
- A strong call to return to God before judgment unfolds

👉 Theme: God is drawing a line—choose life or face consequences

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### 2. Warning Against Corruption in Religion

- Matthew 16:11 – “Beware of the leaven of the Pharisees”

“Leaven” represents influence—especially false teaching, hypocrisy, and hidden corruption.

Prophetically, this signals:

- Exposure of religious systems that appear righteous but are inwardly corrupt
- A warning to discern truth from man-made doctrine and control

👉 Theme: Spiritual deception will be exposed

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### 3. An Invitation to Intercede and Ask

- Esther 5:3 – “What is your request, Queen Esther?”

This is powerful in a prophetic sense:

- God is inviting His people to ask boldly
- Like Esther, it’s a moment of intercession for deliverance

👉 Theme: A window of favor—prayer and bold requests matter now

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### 4. A Mandate to Rebuild What Was Broken

- Nehemiah 10:3 – rebuilding the wall
- Ezra 5:2 – Zerubbabel & Jeshua rise to build the temple *with the prophets helping*

This is a major shift:

- Not just spiritual awakening—but restoration and rebuilding
- Leadership (civil and spiritual) working together under prophetic guidance

Prophetically:

- Restoration of true worship, order, and protection
- Rebuilding what has been torn down morally, spiritually, or socially

👉 Theme: God raises builders—restoration begins

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### 5. Confronting Economic Oppression and Injustice

- Nehemiah 5:2 – people crying out due to debt and slavery

This is strikingly relevant:

- Highlights economic bondage, inequality, and exploitation
- In Nehemiah’s time, righteous leadership corrected injustice

Prophetically:

- Exposure of unjust systems
- A call for justice, relief, and righteous governance

👉 Theme: God hears the cry of the oppressed

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## 6. Purging Wickedness and False Systems

- Zechariah 5:8 – removal of wickedness (often interpreted as false systems, corruption, and commercial sin)

This vision symbolizes:

- The removal of entrenched evil
- Judgment against corrupt economic and religious structures

Prophetically:

- Cleansing of systems built on greed, deception, and idolatry

👉 Theme: God removes what is corrupt to establish what is holy

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### ◆ Putting It All Together (Prophetic Flow)

If you read these as a unified message, the progression looks like this:

1. A call to seek God before judgment (Joel, Amos)
  2. Exposure of false religion and deception (Matthew)
  3. An invitation to intercede and partner with God (Esther)
  4. Raising up leaders to rebuild truth and order (Ezra, Nehemiah)
  5. Addressing injustice and economic oppression (Nehemiah 5)
  6. Final cleansing of corrupt systems (Zechariah)
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### 🔥 A Possible Prophetic Interpretation

This collection could be pointing to a season where:

- God is calling people back urgently
  - Corruption (especially spiritual and institutional) is being exposed
  - There is a window of grace for intercession and change
  - God is raising builders, reformers, and righteous leaders
  - Systems of debt, oppression, and exploitation are confronted
  - Ultimately, a purification takes place to restore what is right

Prophetic interpretation should always be held with humility:

- These patterns can apply personally, spiritually, or corporately
- Not every connection is necessarily predictive—it may also be instructional
- The clearest takeaway is the call to seek God, discern truth, and act righteously

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
